

EDUCATIONAL NOTIFICATION

No. AHSEC/EXB/Fee Exemption/2017-2018/8158 : The Govt. in Secondary Education Department vide No. PMA(S) 25/2017/19 dated 24.5.2017 has decided to continue waiving of examination fees on an extended scale and has given a direction to the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council to waive examination fee of students whose annual income of their parents taken together from all sources is below or Rs.1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh) only for the ensuing HS Final Examination, 2018. This year in addition to the Examination fee, centre fees charged by the Examination Centres for running the Examination are also waived for the poor students appearing in the ensuing examination subject to observance of the conditions as laid down in the Notification printed overleaf.

The students of the Institutions belonging to the categories – Government/ provincialised/ recognized venture School and Colleges shall be covered by this Govt. decision. The selection of eligible regular students shall be done by the Head of Institution where students are studying and submit the list of such exempted students to the Council in due course. While submitting the proposal for fee exemption with relevant documents to the Council the Head of Institutions shall certify about the eligibility of the students for availing of such benefit. In compliance of the Govt. directives the Head of Institutions shall not charge Examination fee and Centre fee from the selected economically backward students during filling up of Examination forms and statement for the coming examination. The Head of the Institutions shall strictly adhere to the conditions stipulated in the notification for exemption of examination and centre fee.

The students belonging to private run Junior Colleges/HS Schools and Institutional Private candidates shall not come under the purview of this Govt. decision.

No. PMA(S) 25/2017/19: As communicated by Govt. letter No. PMA(S) 184/2016/9 dated 03-11-2016 Government of Assam in Secondary Education Department issued instruction to exempt the fees payable to the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council for appearing in the Higher Secondary Examination and Board of Secondary Education, Assam for appearing in the High School Leaving Certificate Examination/ Assam High Madrassa Examination from the Government/ provincialized/ recognized venture School/ Colleges for the students whose annual income of their parents taken together from all sources is below or Rs 1.00 Lakh (Rupees one lakh) only.

After careful consideration Government of Assam in Secondary Education Department have decided to continue waiving of examination fees on an extended scale. This year, in addition to the Examination fees, centre fees, charged by the Examination Centre for running the Examination will also be waived for the poor students appearing in HSLC and HSSLC examinations subject to observance of the following conditions:

1. For exempting the examination fees, center fees, school fees for examination etc of the student, the parents/guardian have to declare his income and the student will be eligible only if the income from all sources of the family is Rs 1.00 Lakh or below of it.
2. In support of the claim, the parent has to furnish some supporting evidence. The concerned head of the institution after examining the claim will allow the fees exemption of the student.
3. The fees amount thus not realized from the students directly by the AHSEC/SEBA due to the waiver of examination fees and centre fees, shall be reimbursed by the State Government after receipt of proposal from the AHSEC and SEBA through the Director of Secondary Education, Assam.
4. The AHSEC and SEBA, at the time of claiming reimbursement of examination fees should submit centre-wise and challan-wise detail list of exempted fees indicating nos of beneficiaries covered.
5. The reimbursement proposal must accompany the Utilization Certificate and progress report of previous grants.
6. The school can not collect any fees from the poor students for conduct of examination.
7. Duties and responsibilities of the students availing the scheme: It is mandatory for all the students of class X and the students seeking admission into HS 1st Year to have a tree plantation at their schools/colleges, at their homes or surrounding environment at the beginning of the academic session and place a photograph of his plantation work before the head of the institution. The student has to nurse the sapling and the same students at the time of appearing HSLC examination and after attaining Class-XI & XII as the case may be, have to place photograph of the self nurtured tree showing the progress of his plantation work before the head of the institution.
